Each one helped to develop the basic concept, adapting it to a specific part of the ship in accordance with their skills, their experience and their own sensibilities. Then some of the most prestigious Italian brands in the field of interior décor became involved offering the team the very best Italian-made items. The result of the challenge to tell the story of Italian beauty on a cruise ship is how Costa Smeralda was created.

The secret was starting with Italy’s most typical settings, from the architectural landmarks that embody and reflects the Italian lifestyle where people go to see others, drink aperitifs, have a conversation, eat mouthwatering snacks, shop, but above all, to have a great time together, this can only happen in the most traditional of Italian places, the piazza.

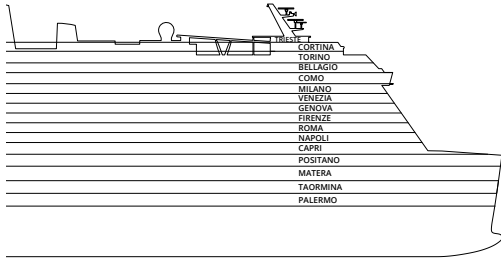
