Check in at Split harbour from 14 hours onwards. Enjoy our guided tour of Split, a historic town under UNESCO protection and a part of the world heritage – of special interest is the magnificent Diocletian palace, once inhabited by the Roman emperor. Return to the ship for a welcome cocktail and enjoy the meet & greet party on board. Overnight in Split.

Sunday SPLIT - KORČULA (B,L)

Early morning departure towards Korčula Island, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays on route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this ancient town with fortified walls. Overnight in Korčula.

KORČULA - MLJET/DUBROVNIK (B.L.D)

Next morning we head further south to the Island of Mliet. Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating from the 12th Century. Return to the ship for lunch after which we depart towards Dubrovnik with late afternoon arrival, Before we tie the ropes at Gruž harbour the captain will take you for a cruise along side the old city walls while a buffet dinner is served on deck to enjoy the spectacular views of the city walls. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Tuesday DUBROVNIK (B)

Today you have a whole day to enjoy this magical town. After breakfast transfer to the old town for the guided walking tour followed by a cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and Elaphiti Islands enabling you to take best pictures of the old town. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

DUBROVNIK PELJEŠAC PENINSULA (B.L.D)

In the morning we will leave this magnificent town and continue our cruise towards the little seaside village on the Pelješac peninsula, well known for it excellent wine. Before lunch a short stop at one of the Elaphiti Islands and afternoon arrival to Pelješac peninsula. Transfer to the village Kuna for a tour of the local church and monastery followed by a visit to a local farm where you will indulge in a typical village evening with Croatian delicacies, an all inclusive dinner with local dishes made from their own produce. Late transfer back to the ship. Overnight on Pelješac peninsula.

HVAR - BOL - MILNA or PUČIŠĆA (B.L.CD)

Bol is a typical fishermen's town turned into a popular tourist destination. After lunch on board time at leisure until Captain's farewell dinner with live entertainment on board. Overnight in nearby Milna or Pučišća.

Transfer from Split airport to the Split harbor for check in from 14.00h onwards. After settling, enjoy the guided tour of Split, a historic town under UNESCO protection and part of the world heritage with the magnificent Diocletian palace, once inhabited by the Roman emperor. After the tour, return to the ship for a welcome meet & greet cocktail reception on board. Overnight in Split.

SPLIT – (BOL) HVAR (B, L) Sunday

Morning departure to Brač island where swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat near Bol. Continue towards the jet-set island Hvar with lunch on board at the Pakleni Islands. Hvar is the longest and sunniest island in the Adriatic known for lavish lavender fields and breathtaking beauty. Afternoon arrival followed by a tour of the town's historical landmarks. Hike up to the town fort and enjoy abundance of entertainment in the evening hours. Overnight in the port.

Monday HVAR – BIŠEVO (Blue Cave) / VIS (B, L, T)

Early morning cruise towards small island Biševo to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (depending on the weather conditions). Continue to the island of Vis, once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public. Try some exquisite wine sorts in one of the local traditional wineries. Overnight in the port of Vis.

Tuesday VIS – KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour. Optional excursion to small village near Korčula for typical Dalmatian dinner and to find out more about the history and traditional way of living. Overnight in Korčula.

Wednesday KORČULA – MLJET (B, L)

This morning we head further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery dating back to the 12th Century. Alternatively, you can rent kayaks, bicycles, scooters or convertible

cars to roam around island on your own. Overnight in port Polača or Pomena.

Thursday

MLJET - SLANO/STON (B.L.T.CD)

the mainland, a peaceful fishermen's village and the starting point to Ston, another, once fortified small village famous for its oysters. After exploring the town's medieval ramparts a short coastal walk leads us to an oyster farm to learn more about oysters and tasting this delicious treat. Transfer to the ship for the Captain's dinner with entertainment.

Departure for a small village called Slano on

SLANO – DUBROVNIK (B, L)

Early morning departure to Dubrovnik. The special charm of this ancient town are the buildings that have remained from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Before we tie the ropes at Gruž harbour cruise alongside the old Dubrovnik city walls while lunch is served on deck. After docking, transfer to the old town for the guided walking tour of this magical town ending with the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and Elaphiti Islands. Time at leisure for dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik.

Saturday DUBROVNIK Check out (B)

Saturday OPATIJA – RAB (L, T)

Departure at 14h towards Rab, known as the "island of love", with an old town of the same name. Guided city tour includes the medieval walls, the famous four towers together with palaces, churches and squares. There is a slight Montmartre feel with many artists painting and exhibiting out on the streets. Legend has it that local nuns created a special Rab cake for a visiting Pope and we will sample this after the tour. The recipe remains forever secret.

RAB – ZADAR (B, L) Sunday

After breakfast we head for Zadar, the oldest university town in Croatia with an amazing heritage and where history looks you in the eyes: The Roman Forum from the 1st century, St Donat church from the 9th century - the most famous medieval Basilica and the city's symbol, the mighty city walls, over 30 churches Museums and former noble families palaces and villas in the old town. In recent years Zadar has added a touch of cool with the famous Sea Organs and "Greeting to the Sun" light installations, both located on the city's waterfront. Watch the fabulous sunset

Monday ZADAR – KRKA WATERFALLS /

Wine and waterfalls! Cruise towards Skradin. First stop is the famous Bibich winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch. Back in Skradin we walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park and visit "Skradinski Buk". Jaw droppingly beautiful, this is the most popular part of the waterfall area. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. Šibenik is almost in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast and it is our afternoon destination. Explore the alorious old town, the cultural monuments and possibly the most famous one here, the UNESCO listed Cathedral of St James. Wander and discover the historic core and waterfront of Šibenik and enjoy some shopping too. Dinner on board.

ŠIBENIK – SPLIT (B, L) Tuesday

We continue south to Split, Croatia's second largest city where Roman Emperor Diocletian built himself a retirement palace now under UNESCO protection. Split waterfront is a happening place and there's a buzz along the beautiful wide promenade. A local guide meets us on arrival for a walk through the heart of the bustling old town and the market.

Wednesday SPLIT – METKOVIĆ (B, L, CD)

Today we discover one of the last remaining wetland deltas in Europe. We cruise to Metković, on the banks of the river Neretva after which the delta is named. Here, mandarins grow by the water channels and we take a barge ride to explore the groves, the flora and fauna, wild birds and the traditional way of life of the Neretva people. There is a delightful, "time warp" feeling like nowhere else on the coast. Narona archeological museum in Vid, which we visit, was formally inaugurated in 2007 as the first "in situ" museum in Croatia exhibiting the remains of a Roman temple. Narona holds the remains of a Roman temple - the Augusteum – and seventeen monumental marble sculptures of Roman emperors and their family members. This is where the ancient Illyrians, Greeks, Romans once sailed, and, according to legend, the pirates of Neretva planned their raids on enemy galleys. Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board scheduled for this evening.

Thursday METKOVIĆ – KORČULA (B, L) Departure towards Korčula, an island best

known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, the famous explorer. Covering much of the island are the distinct, almost black pine forests so Korčula is also known as "the Black Island". Korčula Town is often called mini Dubrovnik. as it is also encased by medieval stone ramparts and towers. The famous Moreška sword dance-fight is thought to have come to the island when the Moors raged through this region and there are regular performances. A local guide will lead you through the old town where tiny streets are designed in a fish bone pattern for a very good reason that you will hear about! Lots of simple konobas, restaurants and cool cocktail hars for chill out

KORČULA – DUBROVNIK (B. L)

There is no better way to catch the first sight of your final destination - the famous town Dubrovnik - than approaching from the sea. It is one of the few walled cities on the sea in the world. Writer George Bernard Shaw described it as "heaven on earth". We cruise alonaside the old city walls for a true perspective of the majesty of this place. Lunch is served on deck as we head for Gruž harbour to dock. Once moored, join a transfer to the old town for a guided walking tour. Take the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain for fabulous views of the city itself and the Elaphiti Islands. In your own time, why not walk those famous ramparts (all 1940 metres long!), or explore any of the museums in more detail, such as Sponza or Rectors, now is the time.

Saturday DUBROVNIK (B)

After breakfast it is time to say goodbye to your new friends and crew - for now at least.



ITINERARY:

Saturday OPATIJA - KRK (L, T)

Departure for Krk at 14h with lunch on board. Krk is the largest Croatian island and on route

we stop to swim in the most crystal clear water you may ever have seen. Krk has diverse villages, stunning promenades, dramatic rock

faces with tiny islands and hundreds of hidden

bays and beaches. There is a buzz along the waterfront of Krk Town. Enjoy the many bars or restaurants there and relax. Afternoon wine tasting in Vrbnik village with bus transfer.

KRK - RAB (B. L. T)

After breakfast, we cruise towards Rab island known as the "island of love". On arrival, there are the imposing stone walls and you will see Romanesque church towers, churches, palaces, stone streets and ancient facades. Many streets and squares are like open-pair galleries, as artists work outside. Do not miss and try the famous "Rapska torta" cake (the receipe is secret). If weather permits, walk up to Kamenjak hill and watch the magnificent sunset. Overnight in town of Rab.

RAB - ZADAR (B, L)

Morning cruise from Rab towards Zadar. travelling by Pag island with it's unusual moonlike landscape. We stop to swim on tiny Maun island. In Zadar there is a guided tour of the city which is the center of the region and was the metropolis of Dalmatia region for many centuries. The rich cultural heritage is visible at every turn: The Roman forum which dates to the 1st century AD, the church of St. Donatus dating to the 9th century AD - the most famous Medieval basilica and the symbol of the city. The imposing and mighty city walls with representative Port and Land gates are from the 16th century AD, and there are numerous palaces and villas of former noble families. Great restaurants line part of the waterfront and the centre of town. Famous, contemporary creations are the Zadar Sea Organ, one of a kind in the world (listen to the sound) and "The Greeting to the Sun" light installation. Overnight in Zadar.

ZADAR - KORNATI (B, L) Tuesday

Today we visit the region of the famous National Park Kornati – rich in fish and cultural and historic remains. Historic remains of old Ilyrian fortress, Roman villas, old Christian church of St. Mary and medieval fortresses and settlements add to the value of these islands. Kornati consists of 140 islands and reefs. Inlets of some islands descend steeply into the sea, a hundred meters deep in places, and dramatically razor sharp. It is truly something remarkable to see. Overnight in Telašćica Bay on Dugi Otok. Possibility to walk to the white

cliffs vertically falling down 90 m into the sea and rising up to 200 m over the sea as well as the salt Lake "Mir".

Wednesday KORNATI - MALI LOŠINJ (B, L)

After breakfast and a morning swim, we cruise towards Lošinj known as "sunshine island" and abundance of pines, wild flowers and herbs. Lošinj is one of the most popular islands on the northern Adriatic waters for its hidden coves and cool Mediterranean vibe. On arrival to Mali Lošini, enjoy walking tour followed by visit to Museum of Apoxyomenos. The museum is dedicated to the ancient bronze statue of an athlete found in the sea near the island. Walk up to the Lošinj Aromatic Garden or to the smaller town of Veli Lošini both easy to reach and explore on foot. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

Thursday MALI LOŠINJ - CRES (B. L)

We leave for Cres island after our morning swim. Possible swim stop on island Susak, if weather permits. This unspoiled island is long and narrow with olive groves, vineyards, forests of oak, beech and remarkable stone walls. Cres and Mali Lošini were once one island before the Romans dug a narrow channel to separate them. Optional dinner in village Loznati (with transfer from Cres) where you can try the best traditional lamb specialties this island has to offer. Altarnatively spend the night in the harbor of this typical medival town - Cres - with Cres with hidden squares and courtyards.


Friday CRES - OPATIJA (B. L. CD)

After breakfast, we leave for Opatija. The famous Opatija Riviera is best seen from the sea. We arrive in late afternoon. Saturday SPLIT - TROGIR (L)

14.00h is our departure time from Split harbor, late arrivals can join in Trogir. After lunch, we cruise to the old Dalmatian town of Trogir (Greek relief from 4th century was found here). Troair is sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a "mini Dubrovnik" because of its ancient walls, or a floating museum town - as it has a masterful architecture including some stunning Venetian palaces. Join our guided tour of Trogir with a local tour guide. The old town is an UNESCO heritage site and there is a great choice of bars and restaurants. Overnight in Trogir.

Sunday TROGIR – ŠIBENIK (B. L)

Šibenik is located almost in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast and is our todays destination. Enjoy the guided tour of the glorious old town Šibenik, the cultural monuments and possibly the most famous one here, the UNESCO listed Cathedral of St James. Wander and discover the historic core and waterfront. Some good boutique shopping too. Overnight in Šibenik.

ŠIBENIK – KRKA WATERFALLS (SKRADIN) - ZLARIN or VODICE

Wine and waterfalls! During breakfast, cruise towards Skradin. First stop is the famous Bibich winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch. In the morning or afternoon, we will walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park and visit "Skradinski Buk". Jaw droppingly beautiful, this is the most popular part of the waterfall area. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. Overnight in Vodice or Zlarin, depending on the state of the port and port authorities. Vodice are a typical Dalmatian town and Zlarin is a tiny island in the Šibenik

ZLARIN OR VODICE – KORNATI / SALI (B. L)

Today we visit the Kornati National Park which is actually made up of 89 islands. This is really something remarkable to see as inlets on some islands descend steeply into the sea, a hundred meters deep in places, and are dramatically razor sharp. The islands are rich in fish and cultural and historic remains. There are ruins of old Ilvrian fortress, Roman villas, the old Christian church of St. Mary and medieval fortresses and settlements among these islands. Overnight is in Sali on Long Island (Dugi Otok in Croatian).

There are many superb restaurants in the center and by the waterfront. From historic places to the contemporary, don't miss a visit to the famous Zadar Sea Organ and "The Greeting to the Sun" light installation, both are spectacular. Overnight in Zadar.

Thursday ZADAR – ROGOZNICA (B, L, CD)

During breakfast, we continue our journey towards Rogoznica. Lunch is served en route followed by a stop in a quiet bay (known only to the Captain!) for an afternoon swim. Overnight in Rogoznica - a small village that offers many restaurants and small cafes. Do try the famous Babic wine that is made locally. Captain's dinner with live music on board.

Friday ROGOZNICA - SPLIT (B, L)

Morning departure towards the Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula. On this Island you can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else while you wander along the herringbone pattern streets with our guided tour. local inhabitants, but also to the many visitors who fall in love with this 1,000 plus year old beauty. Join a sightseeing tour of the old town including Diocletian's palace which the Roman emperor had built as his retirement home

Wednesday SPLIT- BOL / HVAR (B, L)

Early morning departure we continue our cruise towards the island of Brač - Bol, best known for its famous Zlatni rat beach (Golden horn), a natural phenomenon that with its distinct shape and form dominates other beaches of Croatia. Our next destination is Hvar, the longest island in the Adriatic. While you enjoy our guided tour, you can see magnificent, Renaissance cathedral with its original tower; also, the oldest community theatre in Europe which was founded here in 1612. Hvar Town offers plenty of restaurants, bars cafes and clubs, open long into the night. Hvar is often referred to as the sunshine and jet-set island.

Thursday HVAR - MLJET (B, L)

Saturday DUBROVNIK (D)

Transfer from Dubrovnik airport to Dubrovnik Gruž harbor for check in from 14.00h onwards. After settling in, transfer to the city gates for a guided tour of the city. The special charm of this ancient town are the buildings that remain from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Many of the monuments belong to the modest Renaissance architecture with some traces of Gothic style. Take the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the mighty ramparts and of the Elaphiti Islands. After the tour, join a return transfer to the ship for a welcome / meet & greet cocktail reception on board. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Sunday DUBROVNIK - PERAST -KOTOR (B. L)

After breakfast we head to the town of Kotor. As we are traveling from one country to another, there will be some formalities at the border. Upon arrival join a transfer to Perast (approximately 30 min) by bus. In Perast we take a smaller boat to visit the artificial island Our Lady of the Rock the church known for its tablet collection and magnificent paintings. Return to Kotor by bus, to visit old city of Kotor - protected by UNESCO and described as "the most attractive corner of the old continent". The magnificent Cathedral of St. Triphun was built in 1166, on the ruins of the temple of the 9th century and is the beautiful example of sacred architecture. The Old City of Kotor is a well preserved urbanization typical of the middle Ages. Many other monuments include numerous churches and palaces and Napoleon's Theatre from the 19th century. Overnight in Kotor.

Monday - BUDVA **CETINJE** NJEGUŠ - KOTOR (B. L D)

A morning coach excursion to Budva. Visit old town ramparts and citadel that are bordered by the waves of the Mediterranean. Budva is the capital of the Montenegrin Riviera with its 21 km long coast and numerous beaches. Old town of Budva lies on a small peninsula and represents a treasure chest of cultural heritage. Crossed with narrow streets and squares are famous buildings such as the St. Trojica Church. Departure towards old royal Cetinje magical city at the foot of the Mount Lovćen, the historical, cultural and spiritual capital of Montenegro. Guided visit of the city with entrance to the King Nikola's museum. Continue towards Njeguši, cradle of Montenegrin royal family. Lunch in a traditional restaurant, tasting local ham and cheese with red wine. Continue towards the coast, driving by the old serpentine road overlooking Boka Bay. Return to Kotor, where your vessel awaits. Dinner on board, overnight in Kotor.

Tuesday KOTOR - ŠIPAN (B, L, CD)

Early morning departure towards Croatia. After the formalities and crossing the border,

we continue our trip towards the Elafiti islands, a group of islands west of Dubrovnik, which were a part of a glorious Dubrovnik Republic through centuries and therefore shared its wealth. After the Republic lost its significance, the residents left the Elaphiti and now only three islands are inhabited. They include Šipan, Lopud and Koločep (Kalamota) and attract numerous tourists with their beautiful scenery and sandy beaches. Šipan, the largest island of the Elafiti, is also the most distant from Dubrovnik. Tonight you will get to enjoy

Wednesday ŠIPAN - KORČULA (B, L)

In the morning, we continue our cruise towards the Island of Korčula, best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town with fortified walls. On this island, you can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else while you wander along the herringbone pattern streets. Korčula has an abundant choice of restaurants where you can continue your gourmet experience. There are many bars and clubs for those looking for evening entertainment. Overnight in Korčula.

KORČULA - MLJET (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the island of Mljet with a swim stop on Pelješac peninsula. Part of Mljet island is a National Park (entrance fee included) and, in the afternoon, we visit the seawater lakes, then cross to the peaceful, tiny St Mary's isle in the middle of the large lake to visit the church and the monastery. Walk or hire a bike to explore paths and trails around these stunning lakes. Overnight in the port of Polača/Pomena depending on weather and

MLJET - DUBROVNIK (B. L)

There is no better way to catch the first sight of your final destination - the famous town Dubrovnik - than approaching from the sea. It is one of the few walled cities on the sea in the world. Writer George Bernard Shaw described it as "heaven on earth". We cruise alongside the old city walls for a true perspective of the majesty of this place. Once moored, you have an afternoon to wander and explore Dubrovnik on your own. Walk those famous ramparts (all 1940 meters long!) or visit museums such as Sponza or Rectors, now is the time.



Saturday SPLIT - OMIŠ/PUČIŠĆA (L)

Departure from Split is followed by lunch on board and a swim break. Continue to Omiš or Pučišća on Brač island. In Omiš you can experience Cetina river rafting or zip line over Cetina river canyon. Pučišća is a typical Mediterranean place, cradle of the world's most famous white stone of Brač used in Liverpool Cathedral, White House in Washington and more. Possibility of visiting a stone masonry workshop. Overnight in the port of Pučišća or Omiš.

Sunday OMIŠ/PUČIŠĆA – KORČULA (B, L)

After a morning swim in the crystal blue sea, we cruise toward Korčula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch will be served either on the tip of the Pelješac peninsula (near Lovište) or in the quiet bay of Kneža on Korčula. Afternoon arrival in Korčula. Overnight in the port.

Monday KORČULA – LASTOVO (B, L, CD)

We continue our cruise towards Lastovo, the farthest, inhabited island in Dalmatia, which Romans called the Imperial island. Wednesday KOMIŽA/VIS – BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) – STARIGRAD (B, L)

Early in the morning we cruise toward the little Biševo island to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of our visit will depend on those conditions. After a short visit to Komiža/Vis town, we continue towards Stari grad on the Hvar island, the sunniest island in the Adriatic.

Thursday STARI GRAD - BOL (B, L)

After breakfast we cruise toward the beautiful Brač island and the famous town of Bol. Swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Zlatni Rat (the Golden Horn). Bol is a typical fishermen's town converted into a popular tourist destination. Hike or rent a scooter up to Vidova Gora for a spectacular view of Bol and surroundings. Overnight.

Friday BOL – SPLIT (B, L)

The last day is spent mostly relaxing and swimming in different quiet bays of Brač island. Late afternoon return to Split, where we recommend



Wednesday ZADAR - ZLARIN (B, L, CD)

Today we head back, travelling south along the Dalmatian coast, with a swimming stop in one of the beautiful bays. With just hundreds of permanent inhabitants in winter, in summer Zlarin welcomes around 3,000 to this lovely car-free island. Overnight in a village on a tiny Zlarin island in the Sibenik archipelago, with Captain's dinner included on Premium superior and Premium category.

Thursday ZLARIN - TROGIR (B, L)

After breakfast, we depart for a swimming stop in one of the bays where lunch will be served. Departure toward the old Dalmatian town -Trogir, sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a floating museum town. The old town is an UNESCO heritage site and there is a great choice of bars and restaurants. Overnight in Trogir.

Friday TROGIR - SPLIT (B, L)

Back to Split Riviera with a whole day of swimming ahead! Stop in one of the bays on the Čiovo island (connected to Trogir by a bridge). Late afternoon we continue toward the last port of call while enjoying the magnificent view of Split Riviera. Join our guided tour of Split with an English speaking guide – of special interest is the Diocletian palace. Overnight in Split.

Check in from 13.00 h onwards in Gruž harbour with dinner as your first meal on board. Dubrovnik - a unique town on the Adriatic with its special charm, dates back to the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Monday DUBROVNIK – MLJET (B, L)

After breakfast we continue our journey towards the island and national park Mljet. Lunch on board. The whole afternoon is free to enjoy the salt lakes in the National Park and enjoy the sun and sea on this peaceful island. In the middle of the large lake, inside the National park, one can visit an old abbey and a church. Bicycles can be hired to cycle around the paths that surround the lakes or cars for those wanting to go further into the island. Overnight in port Polača / Pomena.

Tuesday MLJET – HVAR (B, L)

Early in the morning we depart towards the little island Šćedro where we will have enough time to relax and refresh in the clean, crystal blue sea. Departure for Hvar after lunch, the longest island in the Adriatic, often referred to as the sunshine and jet set island.

Wednesday HVAR - (BOL) SPLIT (B, L)

Our next stop is Brač island where swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Zlatni Rat near Bol (the Golden Horn). Bol is a typical fishermen's village converted into a popular tourist destination. After lunch we will start our journey to Split.

ursday SPLIT – KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco

Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula. On this Island you can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else while you wander along the herringbone pattern streets. Korčula has an abundant choice of restaurants where you can continue your gourmet experience and there are many bars and clubs for those looking for evening entertainment. Overnight in Korčula.

Friday KORČULA – ŠIPAN (B, L, CD)

Early in the morning we continue our trip towards the Elafiti islands, a group of islands west of Dubrovnik. They include Šipan, Lopud and Koločep (Kalamota). Swimming and lunch is planned at one of the smaller Elafiti islands. Šipan, the largest island of the Elafiti, is also the most distant from Dubrovnik. Overnight.

Saturday ŠIPAN – DUBROVNIK (B, L)

Early departure for Dubrovnik with breakfast on route. Enjoy the nature along the way towards "the heaven on earth" - according to the famous writer George Bernard Shaw. Lunch on board and arrival to Dubrovnik early in the afternoon. Explore Dubrovnik on your own or join our guided tour of Dubrovnik with an English speaking guide. Overnight in the port of this magical town.

Departure at 13 h from Split harbour. Cruise along Dalmatian coast toward Makarska while enjoying your lunch. After arriving to Omiš, a picturesque town surrounded by steep rocky mountain cliffs, where we will have a refreshing swim stop. From here, we recommend trying Cetina river rafting or zip line over Cetina river canyon. Overnight in Makarska, the famous tourist destination with many restaurants and bars and a beautiful promenade along the famous beach.

MAKARSKA – BOL (BRAČ) - STARI GRAD (B, L)

This morning we continue our cruise toward the next destination - the island of Brač, more precisely to the town of Bol, known for its famous Zlatni Rat beach (Golden horn). After swimming break and lunch we continue our journey towards Stari Grad on the Hvar, the sunniest Adriatic island. Free afternoon to explore this unique town, a part of world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in one of the ports of

STARI GRAD - HVAR (B, L)

ITINERARY:

Saturday SPLIT – MAKARSKA (L)

Our next destination is the town of Hvar, a favourite destination for jet setters from all around the world. After lunch we stop for swimming, relaxing and refreshment in clear, crystal blue sea at nearby Pakleni islands. Arrival to Hvar in the afternoon hours. We recommend sightseeing of this extraordinary town with many restaurants and bars serving drinks late into the night.

HVAR – (BLUE CAVE) VIS (B, L)

Early in the morning we cruise towards the little Biševo island to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. We continue towards the island of Vis, which was a strategic Yugoslav navy harbour due to its unique geographical position and as such it was closed to the public until recently. Overnight in the town of Vis, situated on the northern side of the island, developed near the remains of the ancient Issa, first urban centre in Croatia

Wednesday VIS – KORČULA (B, L)

Early departure toward Korčula, the birthplace of famous explorer and adventurer Marco Polo. Surrounded by medieval walls, Korčula resembles a miniature Dubrovnik when approaching from the sea. It has more legends, tales and monuments than you will find anywhere else. Overnight in port.

KORČULA – MLJET – ŠIPAN or SLANO (B, L, CD)

We continue cruising toward one of the greenest Adrigatic islands - the island of Mljet, where on the western part, the National Park is situated. Explore the beauties of the National Park where cycling around, canoeing or swimming in the lakes is permitted. We continue our cruise towards Šipan, part of Elaphite islands near Dubrovnik, or towards Slano on the coastline, both are small fishermen's villages where we will overnight in the port and have Captain's Dinner on board.

ŠIPAN or SLANO – DUBROVNIK (B, L)

Early in the morning we depart towards our final destination - a true pearl of the Adriatic. We recommend sightseeing of Dubrovnik followed by a cable car ride up to Srđ mountain for a spectacular view of the old town, as well as a stroll along the city walls. Overnight in Gruž port.





Saturday OPATIJA - ISLAND KRK (L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (18 km)

Arrival in Opatija and check in at Opatija harbour from 11:00. Departure at 13:00 followed by lunch on board on journey to the island of Krk. During the boat ride you will have an opportunity to meet your fellow passengers and the crew. Easy ride from the town Krk to the village of Punat and back to Krk town. Overnight.

Sunday

ISLAND KRK (B, L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 4 (48 km)

Today you will cycle through Mediterranean scented vegetation, olive groves and fig trees to the village of Dobrini - a real town-museum. a synthesis of past and present. Ride through the dry-stone walls and flocks of sheep to the biggest field on the island - Vrbnik's field with its famous golden yellow wine - the Žlahtina. You will rest in Vrbnik while tasting wine, cheese and prosciutto. Continue to the saddle Treskavac with the wonderful view to Punat valley and the small island of Košljun with franciscan monastery dating from 12th century. Downhill through Bašćanska Draga to Baška, getting to know the sculptures of Glagolitic letters. Dinner on board with overnight in Baška. Remark: In case of bad weather conditions (bura wind), end of tour and overnight in Krk.

Monday ISLAND OF RAB (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (22 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (21 km)

During breakfast, the ship cruises to Lopar on the island of Rab - the second greenest croatian island. Our bike tour will lead us to a famous sandy beach bay. We then cycle through the interior of the island, past wonderful Supetarska Draga in the direction of the ancient walled city of Rab with its four famous bell towers situated on an arrow shaped spit of land. After lunch on board we will cycle more to the nature reserve 'Dundo' forest - one of the few surviving forests in the Mediterranean, which extends over the Kalifront peninsula. Swimming break in the picturesque bay St.Mara. Overnight in the port

Tuesday PAG - ILOVIK (B, L, CD) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (35 km)

After a short crossing to the island of Pag we start a bike tour along the island's beautiful moon-like landscape. First stop is the village of Lun with thousand years old olive trees and many stone walls. Be careful when cycling on this island due to many wandering sheep. The island is famous for its Pag cheese. We highly recommend a break in a traditional 'konoba' tavern to taste the cheese. In the idyllic village of Mandre we return to the ship and have lunch on board. We continue our cruise to the island of Ilovik, island full of flowers, where we have opportunity to walk, swimm and relax. Optional Captain's dinner on board with overnight in Ilovik.

Wednesday ISLAND LOŠINJ (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (20 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (22 km)

After breakfast, we leave for Mali Lošinj. Bike tour through the lovely Čikat peninsula surrounded by pine trees and Mediterranean herbs with enjoying the beautiful beaches. Continue to the picturesque village Veli Lošinj and back to the ship for lunch. Afternoon easy ride to one of the beaches or to the Sveti Ivan hill (250m) or the theme viewpoint Providenca where you can enjoy fantastic view to the city and the southern part of the Lošinj archipelago.

Thursday ISLAND OF LOŠINJ AND CRES (B, L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (46 km)

After breakfast, we cycle through the pine and laurel trees towards Cres island (connected to Mali Losini by small bridge) with our first stop in the artistic village of Osor and we take a more strenuous cycling towards the fishing village

of Martinscica where lunch will be served on board. We continue our cruise towards the historic town of Cres for free evening and overnight.

Friday OPATIJA RIVIERA (B, L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (27 km)

During breakfast, the ship departs for Mošćenička Draga on the Opatija riviera. From there we cycle along the coastal road with spectacular views of the sea and the islands to the village of Brseč, situated on a rock above the sea. After the break, we continue to cycle to St Jelena hill with the stunning panorama on Kvarner bay. Descend to Mošćenice - a medieval town situated on the foot of Perun hill and further to Lovran where the ship is waiting. Lunch on board and sailing to Opatija, where you have free evening to admire enchanting city, walk through the parks or along the 12 km long sea promenade called Lungomare. Overnight

Thursday VELA LUKA - HVAR - STARI

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (23 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (22 km)

Early morning sail from Vela Luka to the town of Hvar, breakfast. Short sightseeing of Hvar, a fairy tale city with its architecture, beautiful nature and mild climate. Cycle from Hvar to the other side of the island - Stari Grad. We pass through numerous lavender plants and enjoy the view towards the neighboring islands and mainland. Lunch on board in Stari Grad. Easy afternoon ride up to two Hvar's pearls -Jelsa and Vrboska and through Stari Grad Plain where the ancient Greek land division has been preserved to these days like the system of road and plots. Overnight in Stari

Friday STARI GRAD - STOMORSKA -SPLIT (B, L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (36 km)

The last day we start with cruise from Stari Grad to the island of Šolta. After breakfast. we start cycling from Stomorska to the highest point of the island - Gornje selo, enjoying the views on both sides of the island and the scents of Medditeranean plants. Continue to Maslinica on the west part of the island. Short break and return to Stomorska. Lunch on board and sail to Split. Free afternoon for sightseeing the Diocletian's city that is under UNESCO's protection. Here we find an abundance of Roman architecture - of special interest is the Diocletian palace. Overnight in Split.

Saturday SPLIT - SUPETAR - PUČIŠĆA (L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (25 km)

Arrival in Split and check in from 11:00. Departure at 13:00 followed by lunch on board on journey to the island of Brač. Upon arrival in Supetar you will cycle the coastal road to the northern part of the island of Brač. We are passing the fishing villages Splitska and Postira and arrive in one of the most beautiful small settlements in Europe - Pučišća. Free afternoon for sightseeing this charming place well known for its long stonemason tradition. Overnight in Pučišća.

Sunday PUČIŠĆA - POKRIVENIK / JELSA - SUĆURAJ - LOVIŠTA / KUČIŠTE (B, L, CD)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (32 km)

Breakfast and morning sail towards the longest Croatian island - Hvar with the view on Biokovo mountain. Out starting point is a small picturesque bay Pokrivenik. Starting with ascend to the highest point of the route and descend to the eastern point of Hvar island - Sućuraj, where the boat is waiting. After lunch on board, sail towards the second biggest Croatian peninsula Pelješac and a charming settlement Lovišta or Kučište. Optional Captain's dinner on board. Overnight.

Monday LOVIŠTA / KUČIŠTE - TRSTENIK

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 4 (45km/31 km)

The third-day ride we can call the winepanoramic route. After breakfast we start riding towards Orebić, the city of seafarers and captains. First few kilometers of ascending and then descending with the unique viewpoints on Korčula archipelago. After Orebić ascend to the area where the most famous varieties of Croatian wine succeed. We cross the tunnel Dingač to the

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (18 km)

After breakfast we start with the longest route of the week in which we will cycle the whole island of Korčula. Ascend to Žrnovo village and then to the oldest settlement on the island - Pupnat, where is the highest point of the route. Descend to the south side of Korčula and road ride between one of the most beautiful bay on the island and the steep cliffs above it. We continue the ride through numerous olive groves and vineyards, one of the most famous grape variety Pošip. Short break in the charming place Smokvica on half the way. Descend

starts on Brač island and ends on the island of Šolta, exploring old villages and picturesque bays. Highlights include visiting great cycling on the historic islands and

ITINERARY:

Saturday SPLIT - ROGOZNICA (L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (14 km)

Arrival in Split and check in from 11:00. Departure from Split at 13:00 toward Rogoznica followed by lunch on board where you will have an opportunity to meet your fellow passengers and the crew. Rogoznica is a small peaceful place with beautiful beaches encircled by karst terrain (limestone) and stone. Cycling by the coast road to Zmajevo oko and further through the olive groves and vineyards towards Šarić Courts. Descend to Primošten with overnight

Sunday VODICE - MURTER - DUGI OTOK (B, L, CD)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 2 (26 km) or DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (20 km)

Early morning cruise towards Vodice, a well known touristic place in Dalmatia, that offers a lot of bike trails. Cycle to Tribunj, a picturesque Dalmatian town which historical city center is well known for donkey racing. Continue further to Tisno, a place situated on the island of Murter which is connected with the mainland by the bridge. Ride along the sea and the pine forests to Murter village. Lunch on board and cruise to Dugi otok. In the afternoon we will visit the Nature Park Telašćica and have a pleasant ride from Sali to Telašćica and back. Optional Captain's dinner on board with overnight in Sali.

Monday SALI - BRBINJ - ZADAR (B, L) DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (28 km)

After breakfast we are leaving small fishing village Sali and start cycling along the main island road to the northern part of the island Dugi otok. Dugi otok is a true example of a place where these two opposites are most evident, picturesque villages and secluded

beaches collide with majestic cliffs and lush vegetation. This makes the ride unique. After arrival in Brbinj we will have lunch on board while cruising toward Zadar - the city of 3000 years rich history and cultural heritage. Free afternoon for exploring the town. Overnight in Zadar.

Tuesday ZADAR - PREKO/UGLJAN -TKON/PAŠMAN - VODICE (B, L)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (31 km)

Route runs through two islands. After breakfast, cruise from Zadar to Ugljan - the sunniest island in Zadar archipelago. The route starts in Preko - the biggest place on the island and leads along the coastline to Kali and then to Kukljica. The islands Ugljan and Pašman are connected by the bridge. Pašman is the island without frontiers, the island of joy and happiness, of little people with big hearts. Coming to Tkon where the ship waits. Sail towards Vodice with the great view of the pearls of Kornati islands. Overnight in Vodice.

Wednesday VODICE - SKRADIN - ŠIBENIK (B, D)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (25 km)

Early morning cruise towards Šibenik with panoramic view of the royal town as well as the fortress of St. Nicholas from XVI century. The flow of the river provides a unique sail experience towards Skradin, which lies at the point where the Krka river plunges into the Adriatic Sea. Enjoy a cycling tour to National park Krka, which covers an area of more than 14000 acres on the central and lower part of the Krka river, whose seven waterfalls leave you breathless. Particularly spectacular are waterfalls Roški slap and Skradinski buk. After relax, we continue to Šibenik and have free afternoon

for sightseeing the oldest Croatian native town on the Adriatic. Dinner on board and overnight in Šibenik.

Thursday ŠIBENIK TROGIR (B, L) **DIFFICULTY LEVEL 1 (20 km)**

After breakfast, bike towards the Fortress of St. Nicholas which is located at the entrance to the St. Anthony Channel and was built in the middle of the 16th century as defense from Turkish attacks from the sea. Riding along the coastal path with the beautiful views of the royal city Šibenik. Visiting the Fortress which has recently been listed on UNESCO world heritage list. We continue to two small salty lakes, Vela and Mala Solina used for salt production. Return to Šibenik, lunch on board and cruise towards Trogir, the real Dalmatian pearl with the best preserved Romanesque Gothic cathedral. Overnight in Trogir.

Friday TROGIT - SPLIT (B, L) **DIFFICULTY LEVEL 3 (26 km)**

After breakfast we start cycling the last island of the tour - Čiovo. First part by the coast until Slatina is flat, followed by ascend to the church of our Lady of Prizidnica which dates from 1546, situated between steep cliffs just above the sea, lies on the south-est side of the island. Descend back to Slatine and ascend to the highest point of the island with the unique view of Split, Kaštela and neighboring mountains. Lunch on board during the journey to Split. Free afternoon in Split for walking tour. Overnight in Split





Thursday MARTINŠĆICA - VALUN - CRES (B, L, D)



Enjoying a wonderful panoramic views of Istria, the Kvarner Bay with the islands, the mountains in the Gorski kotar area, Mount Velebit, the Alps, and Italy. Descend to Poklon saddle and transfer to Opatija. After lunch on board, free time to explore Opatija. Overnight in Opatija. Hiking time approx. 3 hours.

Saturday OPATIJA (B)

Breakfast followed by check out until 9AM.



This guided hiking tour in Dalmatia starts in Omiš and ends on Brač Island, both stunning places. During your tour, you will explore amazing coastlines, towns and old villages. You will hike the historic islands and explore Mljet National Park, climb some high peaks and relax on the beaches, eat delicious local food and try robust, local wines.







ITINERARY:

Saturday SPLIT - OMIŠ (L, D)

Check in from 11:00 and departure at 13:00. Lunch during the journey to Omiš. Upon arrival in Omiš, walk tour to the Fortica fortress above town which is located on the top of Omiš Dinara. You can see the whole city, the canyon of Cetina river as well as the islands Brač, Hvar and Šolta. Return to Omiš and overnight. Walking time: approx. 1,5 hours.

Sunday OMIŠ - MAKARSKA (B, L, D)

Breakfast during sail from Omiš to Makarska. After arrival, transfer to the mountain hut 'Pod Vošcem' where starts our hiking tour to the highest peak of Biokovo, and at the same time the second highest Croatian peak - Sveti Jure (1762 m). In the close vicinity of the hut is the peak Vošac (1422 m). The climb to the top is secured by rope. After relaxing and enjoying the view we go the same way back to the mountain hut and further with transfer to Makarska. Walking time: approx. 3,5 hours.

Monday MAKARSKA - MLJET (B, L, CD)

Morning sail towards the island of Mljet with breakfast during cruise. Arrival to Pomena, lunch on board and afternoon walking tour on National park Mljet. Entrance fee to be paid on the spot approx. 17 EUR per person. The main reason why Mljet is proclaimed national park is definitely its two connected salt water lakes, rich flora and a unique appearance of the coast, cliffs, rocks and numerous islets. Hike tour to the peak Montokuc (235m). In return, refreshment in salt lakes. Possibility of Captain's dinner on board. Overnight in Pomena. Walking time: approx. 3,5 hours.

Tuesday PELJEŠAC – KORČULA (B, L, D)

Before breakfast, cruise towards Pelješac peninsula with the dominant peak of Sveti Ilija (960m). Start of hiking tour from Orebić. Easy climbing to Ruskovići village and then further by a hiking path. After approx. 3 hours of hiking we reach the peak, which is one of the widest and the most beautiful viewpoint in Croatian mountains. Descend to Orebić taking less steep path with a wonderful view of archipelago of Korčula town. Arrival to Orebić, boarding the ship and short cruise to Korčula town. Dinner on board and overnight. Walking time: approx. 6 hours.

Wednesday KORČULA – VELA LUKA (B, L, D)

Morning cruise to the other side of the island - to Vela Luka. Walking tour to the hinterland, first to the hill Hum (376m). Climbing the trail, it gradually opens your eyes to Vela Luka bay and then to the sea and neighboring islands After Hum we return to Vela Luka and continue to the cave Vela Špilja - one of the most important archeological prehistoric locality in Europe. Return to the port and overnight in Vela Luka. Walking time: approx. 3,5 hours.

Thursday VELA LUKA - HVAR (B, L, D)

Breakfast and cruise to the longest Croatian island - Hvar. Arrival to Sveta Nedija village, disembark and start of hiking tour to Saint Nicholas (628m), the highest peak of the island. Descend to the other side of the island by less steep path, towards Stari Grad. We go through Stari Grad field - well preserved ancient land division which dates from Greek times. Dinner on board and overnight in the harbor of Stari Grad. Walking time: approx. 6 hrs.

Friday BOL – SPLIT (B, L, D)

Sailing from Stari Grad to Bol with the goal of conquering the highest peak of all Adriatic islands - Vidova gora (780m). Breakfast during sail. We start hike tour in Bol. Arrival to the top with the stunning view of neighboring islands and the world famous beach The Golden Horn. After relaxtime, descend the same way back to Bol, boarding the ship and cruise towards Split during lunch. Free afternoon for exploring the town of Diocletian. Overnight in Split. Walking time: approx. 3,5 hrs.

Saturday SPLIT (B)

Breakfast followed by check out until 9AM.

Day 1 DUBROVNIK (D)

Transfer from Dubrovnik airport to Dubrovnik harbour for check in from 14.00h onwards. After settling in, transfer to the city gates for a guided tour. The special charm of this ancient town are the buildings that have remained from the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. Many of the monuments belong to the modest Renaissance architecture with some traces of Gothic style. Take the cable car from the Old Town to Srđ mountain to enjoy scenic views of the mighty ramparts and of the Elaphiti Islands. Return transfer to the ship for a welcome dinner & cocktail reception. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 2 DUBROVNIK – KORČULA (B, L, WT)

Departure towards Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. While wandering along the herringbone pattern on this Island one can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else. Early afternoon panorama drive through vineyards to visit the famous sandy beach Lumbarda and wine tasting in a well know local winery with grappa and snacks. Overnight in Korčula.

Day 3 KORČULA – HVAR (B, L, WT)

Early departure towards Hvar the longest island in the Adriatic to visit the local farm and enjoy their wine, olive oil and traditional homemade products. See the Lavender museum and distillery with a presentation of a lavender history on the island Hvar. Transfer back to Hvar, for afternoon guided tour. Here one can find the Renaissance cathedral with its original tower; the oldest community theatre in Europe was founded here in 1612. Hvar offers plenty of restaurants, bars and cafes that are open long into the night and is often referred to as the sunshine island. Overnight on Hvar.

HVAR – BLUE CAVE / VIS (B, L, WT, D)

Early morning cruise towards the small island Biševo to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon (entrances to be paid on the spot - approx. 14 EUR). Continue to the island of Vis, once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public for years. Due to this isolation, Vis retains a special charm -"the Mediterranean as it once was" making it really interesting to visit. Enjoy the wine tasting at a local family owned winery with a long wine making tradition. Dinner on board. Overnight in the port of Vis.

VIS – KUĆIŠTE (PELJEŠAC) (B, L, WT, D)

Morning departure towards the Pelješac peninsula, well known for its excellent wine. Lunch onboard and early afternoon transfer to famous Korta Katarina winery, for a guided tour of the production followed with wine tasting. Continuation to family owned Boutique Winery Mikulić in Orebić. Get to know the small family owned winery and traditional wine making process and enjoy the wine tasting of award winning Croatian wines followed with dinner. Late transfer back to the ship. Overnight on Pelješac peninsula.

KUĆIŠTE (PELJEŠAC) – STON/ MALI STON / SLANO (B, WT, CD)

Departure after breakfast towards Trstenik. Transfer to the Croatian Museum of Viticulture Putniković, where the visitors are introduced to the traditional process of wine making, from vineyards to barrels, the historical development of the vines and finally the wine collection, followed by high-quality wine tasting with snacks. Then on to Ston, small village, once fortified, famous for its oysters. After exploring the town's vast medieval ramparts, heading towards Europe's oldest saltworks known as the trademark of Ston, a short coastal walk leads us to an oyster farm to learn more about oysters and a special tasting of this delicacy. Transfer to Slano for the Captain's dinner with live entertainment.

SLANO – DUBROVNIK (B. L)

Enjoy one more day in the most unique town on the Adriatic, Dubrovnik. However, before mooring at Dubrovnik harbour cruise alongside the old Dubrovnik city walls. Enjoy afternoon in Dubrovnik at leisure. We recommend a walk on top of the 1940 m long city walls.







ITINERARY:

Saturday SPLIT – STARI GRAD (L)

Check in from 11:00. Departure at 13h from Split harbor as we continue towards Stari Grad on the island of Hvar where records confirm that this is the sunniest Adriatic island. Free afternoon to explore this unique town and its famous horseshoe shaped bay. The famous Stari Grad Field (a plain) is the oldest in Croatia and the best preserved example of the ancient Greek system of agriculture. Both the old town and this plain are part of the world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in one of the ports of Stari Grad, main or ferry port (2 km away) depending on availability in port.

Sunday STARI GRAD - HVAR (B, L)

We continue towards the jet-set island of Hvar with lunch on board. Hike up the zig-zag path to the town fort overlooking the harbor for lovely scenic views of your ship. Hvar is town known for its nightlife and bars - the place to be, so get yourself dressed and ready to go! The most famous bars are Carpe Diem, Kiva, Sidro, Nautica and many others.

Monday HVAR – MLJET (B, L)

We leave Hvar and cruise towards Mljet island with a stop for a refreshing swim. Arrival in Mljet National Park with wonderful salt water lakes and the emerald green forest that embraces them. The entrance ticket (approx. EUR 15) includes a boat ride to St. Mary's Isle, located on the Big Lake. Alternatively, rent a kayak, bicycles, scooters orconvertible cars to roam around the island on your own. Overnight in the port of Pomena or Polače (depending on port conditions/traffic).

Tuesday MLJET - DUBROVNIK (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the world famous town of Dubrovnik. To fully understand the story behind this historic town and its monumental walls, our guide will take you on a walking tour to discover the history of this once highly important and independent republic. Must do's are walking the stone walls and a cool drink in Buza café-bar out on the rocks. Surprisingly, a kayaking tour around the Dubrovnik walls is one of the best kayaking tours in Croatia with great photo opportunities. The ship overnights in Dubrovnik. Enjoy a night out in Croatia's most famous city. Enchanting and magical.

Wednesday DUBROVNIK - KORČULA (B, L)

After breakfast, the ship departs for Korčula island, believed to be the birth place of explorer Marco Polo. Korčula town is famous too for its awesome city walls and the impressive fish bone street pattern (cooling effect in hot summers) and you will see this while exploring this charming town. Once night falls step out to try out local cocktail bars including Dos Locos cocktail bar – we think it is one of the best!

Thursday KORČULA - MAKARSKA (B, L)

We depart from Korčula in the morning. Swim stop on the way and arrival in Makarska in



Departure at 13:00h with lunch on board followed by a swimming stop in the crystal clear sea at Bunculuka naturist camp. Continue our route to Krk island - the largest of the Croatian islands. Krk has immense variety in its villages large and small, gentle green promenades bare rocky wilderness, tiny islands and hundreds of hidden bays and beaches. Late afternoon arrival in Baška or Punat (depending on harbour and weather conditions). Time at leisure to enjoy the café-bars and restaurants alongside the waterfront. Overnight in Baška or Punat harbour.

Sunday BAŠKA OR PUNAT (ISLAND KRK) - RAB ISLAND (B, L)

After breakfast, we cruise towards Rab Island known as the "island of love". Swimming break at Ciganka (Gypsy) beach - one of the 3 sandy, naturist beaches in Lopar with its unusual shaped sand dunes. Cruise along the Island of Rab enjoying your lunch. Afternoon swim at naturist beach Kandarola, one of the oldest naturist beaches in the world, where British king Edward VIII and Wallis Simpson took a skinny dip (some historians say that the British royal actually started naturism here). Late afternoon arrival in Rab, town which is encircled by medieval walls, Romanesque church towers, churches, palaces, stone streets and ancient facades. Enjoy the "gallery" on the streets and squares where many painters and artists exhibit their works. If time permits walk up to Kameniak hill to enjoy the magnificent sunset. Overnight in town of Rab.

Monday RAB ISLAND - OLIB (B, L)

Early departure from Rab towards Olib island - situated in the northern part of the Zadar archipelago. Swimming stop in one of the naturist bays. Olib is the only village on this island of the same name and often is a surprise to visitors that there are several valuable archaeological sites dating back to the Roman Empire. Overnight in Olib.

Tuesday OLIB - TELAŠĆICA (B, L, CD)

After breakfast and morning swim, we cruise towards Dugi otok Island (Long Island) and Nature park Telašćica. Due to its intense beauty, richness and importance, this bay surrounded by 13 islands and islets, together with 6 islets inside the bay of Telašćica itself,

was proclaimed a Nature Park in 1988. Entrance to Nature Park Telašćica is to be paid on the spot (approx. EUR 10.- per person). Time at leisure to explore the white cliffs and lake. Captain's dinner party on board and overnight in Telašćica.

Wednesday TELAŠĆICA - MOLAT ISLAND or ILOVIK (B. L)

An early departure for Molat or Ilovik island (depending on available space in the small harbours), followed by a swimming stop on the Island of Krava - a Robinson Crusoe type of island where one feels at the call of nature, the return to the almost primeval way of life, the adventurous rhythm of life played by the wind, the sun and the crystal-clear sea. Lunch on board followed by swimming break on the islands of Krknata, just a few meters away from the island Krava and Dugi otok. Overnight in Molat or Ilovik.

Thursday MOLAT ISLAND or ILOVIK - MALI LOŠINJ ISLAND (B. L)

After breakfast and morning swim, we cruise towards island Mali Lošinį with a short stop on llovik ("the island of flowers"), continuing to Lošinį, known as the "sunshine island" and one of the most popular islands on the northern Adriatic, famous for pine trees scent and clear waters. On arrival take a walk along the harbor front or to Lošinį Aromatic Garden or just visit the picturesque town of Veli Lošinį close by. Overnight in Mali Lošinį.

Friday MALI LOŠINJ ISLAND - CRES ISLAND (B, L, D)

After a morning swim, we leave for Cres island, a long and narrow island covered with oak, beech and pine forests as well as vineyards and olive groves. Cres and Mali Lošinj used to be one island but the Romans dug a channel and separated them. For your last night on board we recommend a farewell party on board, a great opportunity for exchanging addresses with other passengers who have by now become new friends. Enjoy evening BBQ party on board.

Saturday CRES ISLAND - OPATIJA (B)

Early morning departure towards Opatija and enjoy the fantastic panorama of Opatija Riviera. After breakfast say goodbye to the crew and hope to see you again aboard Katarina Line cruises.

ITINERARY: FROM SPLIT

Saturday SPLIT - PUČIŠČA (L)

Departure from Split at 13:00h followed by lunch and a swimming break at Ruskamen naturist beach situated 6 km from Omiš. Continue to Pučišća on Brač Island, a typical Mediterranean place, situated on the northern side of the Island. This is the cradle of the world famous Brač white stone. Possibility of visiting one of the few stone masonry workshops left in Europe. Enjoy the domestic food, wine and famous olive oil of this coastal village.

Overnight in the port of Pučišća.

Sundav PUČIŠČA - KORČULA (B. L)

By the time you reach the deck in the morning,

Pučišća will already be behind us. After the morning swimming stop in the crystal blue sea near the Mlaska naturist camp, we cruise toward Korčula - the birthplace of Marco Polo. Lunch will be served either on the tip of the Pelješac peninsula (near Lovište) or in the quiet bay of Kneža on Korčula island. Afternoon arrival in Korčula for guided sightseeing of this exceptional town. According to legend, Korčula was found by Troian hero Anthenor in the 12th century B.C. This island has more legends, tales and monuments than almost any other. In the evening visit one of many sea front restaurants or enjoy the stunning views of the mainland coast and mountains from the waterfront cafes and bars. Overnight in

Monday KORČULA - LASTOVO (B, L, CD)

Before we leave, we suggest a short morning walk through the open market in Korčula where you can buy fresh fruit to enjoy during the day. Swimming stop at one of the naturist beaches on the tiny island of Badija. We continue our cruise towards Lastovo, the furthest inhabited island in Dalmatia, called the Imperial Island. Once docked in Ubli port, there's an opportunity to visit the protected Nature Park or visit the biggest town on the island – Lastovo. The island is surrounded by many smaller islands, with plenty of secluded bays suitable for snorkeling, but also known for many little churches and unusually shaped chimneys. Captain's dinner party on board and overnight in Ubli.

Tuesday LASTOVO - RAVNIK (GREEN CAVE) - KOMIŽA / VIS (B, L)

Early morning departure towards Vis Island, closed to tourists for many years because of its unique geographical position. Vis was a strategic harbour for the navy and due to this isolation Vis has a special charm of the 'Mediterranean as it once was. Continue to little Ravnik island, where the Green cave is situated, named after the unusual light that reflects in the sea from the hole on the roof of the cave. Entrance to the Green Cave is approx. EUR 10.- per person, to be paid on the spot. After a short swim (weather permitting), we sail further to visit the town of Komiža. Komiža is a typical fisherman's village situated on the western part of the island. Enjoy the walk through the narrow allevs or on one of the pebble beaches with fresh water springs, that stretch along the whole eastern side of Komiža bay. Overnight in Vis.

Wednesday VIS - BIŠEVO (BLUE CAVE) - STARI GRAD (B, L)

Early morning, we cruise towards the little Biševo Island to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. Weather conditions here are often variable and our visit will depend on this. Entrance to the Blue Cave is to be paid on the spot (approx. EUR 14.per person). After a swimming break on one of the beaches on Jeronim Island, we continue towards Stari Grad on the Hvar Island, the sunniest Adriatic island. Guided tour of Stari Grad. The famous Stari Grad Field is the oldest in Croatia and the best preserved example of ancient Greek system of agriculture. It is a

part of world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in Stari Grad

Thursday STARI GRAD - BOL (B, L)

Breakfast followed by a short swimming stop near the naturist camp Nudist in Vrboska. During lunch we cruise towards beautiful Brač island and the famous town of Bol. Swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat (the Golden Horn) - its shingle promontory shifts from side to side, changing shape, according to the direction of wind and waves. Bol is a typical fishermen's town now a popular tourist destination vet still unspoiled. Here we have the opportunity to enjoy excellent fresh fish, local wines and other delicacies of this unique island. Hike or rent a scooter to go up high to Vidova Gora for a spectacular view of Bol and surroundings. Overnight in Bol

Friday BOL - ŠOLTA (B, L, D)

Our last day is spent relaxing and swimming in various tranquil bays of Brač Island. We continue towards Šolta Island with a swimming stop in Livka cove and lunch on board. Late afternoon arrival in Stomorska - a town that has everything a modern tourist needs but without losing its small fishing village charm. This place immediately wins over everybody with its rustic charm and the hospitality of the locals. Enjoy evening BBQ party on board. Overnight in Šolta.

Saturday ŠOLTA - SPLIT (B)

Early morning departure towards Split followed by check out. We hope to see you again!



ITINERARY:

SPLIT (D) Saturday

Transfer from Split airport to the Split harbor where the vessel will be docked. Check in from 14.00 h onwards. After settling in, enjoy the guided tour of the city. Split is a historic town under UNESCO protection and a part of the world heritage. One will find an abundance of Roman architecture - of special interest is the magnificent Diocletian palace, once inhabited by the Roman emperor. After the tour of Split, return to the ship for a welcome reception and cocktail to enjoy the meet and greet party on board. Overnight in Split.

SUNDAY SPLIT - HVAR (B, L)

Morning departure towards the jet-set island Hvar. Lunch stop on the small Island of Šćedro followed by a swim stop at the Paklinski Islands. Arrival to Hvar in the afternoon, Hvar is the longest Island in the Adriatic and one of the sunniest: known for lavish lavender fields and breathtaking beauty. Upon arrival, there will be a tour of the town. One can find many historical landmarks in Hvar, the Renaissance cathedral with its original tower, and the oldest community theatre in Europe which was founded in 1612. Hike up to the town fort overlooking the harbour to get some lovely scenic views of your ship and the Paklinski islands. In the evening Hvar offers an abundance of entertainment - many restaurants, bars and cafes are open long into the night. Overnight in Hvar.

HVAR - PELJEŠAC (B, L, D) Monday

Morning departure from this magnificent town to continue our cruise towards the Pelješac peninsula, well known for its excellent wine. Before lunch a short swim stop and afternoon arrival to Pelješac peninsula. Today we move away from the shore inland to explore the rural areas. Afternoon transfer followed by a visit to a local farm to indulge in a typical village party with Croatian delicacies, an allinclusive dinner with local dishes made from their own produce. Late transfer back to the ship. Overnight on Pelješac peninsula.

PELJEŠAC - MLJET - DUBROVNIK Tuesdav (B, L, D)

Next morning we head further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the cruise manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park and enjoy the boat ride to the St Mary Isle, where you will visit an ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating from the 12th Century. Alternatively, you can rent kayaks, bicycles, scooters or convertible cars to roam around the National Park on your own. Return to the ship for lunch followed by departure towards Dubrovnik. Late afternoon arrival in Dubrovnik, but before we tie the ropes at Gruž harbour the captain will take you for an evening cruise along side the old city walls while a buffet dinner is served on deck. Enjoy



the spectacular views of this magnificent old town. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Wednesday DUBROVNIK (B)

After breakfast transfer to the old town for the guided walking tour to enjoy this magical town. You will have the opportunity to take best pictures of the town of Dubrovnik as we take the cable car from the Old Town to Srd mountain to enjoy scenic views of the Walls and Elaphiti Islands. Afternoon at leisure to find idyllic spots for lunch and dinner. For those of you with more enthusiasm, we recommend to walk the famous walls 1,940 m long and take a stroll along the walking street "STRADUN" - both a street and a square, a promenade inside the city walls. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Thursday DUBROVNIK - KORČULA (B, L)

Early morning departure towards the Korčula island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Early afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town with fortified walls. On this Island you can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else while you wander along the herringbone pattern streets. Korčula has an abundant choice of restaurants where you can continue your gourmet experience and there are many bars and clubs for those looking for evening entertainment. Overniaht in Korčula.

KORČULA - BOL (B, L, CD)

Our final stop will be the Island of Brač and picturesque town of Bol. Walk along the promenade or swim at one of the most famous beaches in Dalmatia - Zlatni Rat (the Golden cape - known for its gravel promontory shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change its shape). Bol is a typical fishermen's town turned into a popular tourist destination. Lunch on board and time at leisure. Captain's farewell dinner with entertainment on board. Overnight in nearby Milna or Pučišća.

Saturday BOL - SPLIT (B)

Early morning departure for Split and on arrival it is time to say goodbye to the crew and all your new friends! Check out by 9.00 am and a private transfer to Split airport.

Day 1 ARRIVAL ZAGREB (D)

Arrival to Zagreb and transfer to hotel. Evening at leisure..

Day 2 ZAGREB WALKING TOUR (B)

Morning city tour of Zagreb includes walk through the historic Upper Town, visit the St. Mark's Church, the Cathedral, the Government Palace and the Lotrščak tower. Overnight in Zagreb in 4* hotel.

Day 3 ZAGREB - PLITVICE LAKES - OPATIJA (B)

Morning departure towards the spectacular Plitvice National Park, consisting of 16 lakes, connected with a series of waterfalls. 3 hour walk in this wonderful environment enjoying a boat ride on the emerald green Kozjak Lake and walk back to the entrance. Drive to Overnight in Opatiia in 4* hotel.

Day 4 OPATIJA - RAB (B, L, T)

Check out from the hotel and walking tour of Opatija. Check in on vessel and departure at 13h towards Rab, known as the "island of love" with an old town of the same name. Join us on guided city tours and see the medieval walls and the famous four towers (and maybe climb one of them later!) together with palaces, churches and squares. There's a slight Montmartre feel with many artists painting and exhibiting out on the streets. Legend has it that local nuns created a special Rab cake for a visiting Pope and we will sample this after the tour. The recipe remains forever secret.

Day 5 RAB - ZADAR (B, L)

Zagreb

After breakfast we head for Zadar, the oldest university town in Croatia with an amazing heritage and where history looks you in the eyes: The Roman Forum from the 1st century, St Donat church from the 9th century - the most famous medieval Basilica and the

city's symbol, the mighty city walls, over 30 churches. Museums and former noble families' palaces and villas in the old town. In recent years Zadar has added a touch of cool with the famous Sea Organs and "Greeting to the Sun" light installations, both located on the city's waterfront. Watch the fabulous sunset from here. Guided city tour.

Day 6 ZADAR - KRKA WATERFALLS / ŠIBENIK (B,T,D)

Cruise towards Skradin then board our coach. First stop is the famous Bibich winery for wine tasting and light tapas lunch. Back in Skradin we walk through the Krka Waterfalls National Park and visit "Skradinski Buk". Jaw droppingly beautiful, this is the most popular part of the waterfall area. There are 17 waterfalls, with cascades up to 100 m wide, and the Krka river tumbles 45.7 meters. A never-to-forget experience is swimming under the falls so bring your swimming things and enjoy the crystal clear fresh water. Šibenik, is almost in the very central part of Croatia's Adriatic coast and is our afternoon destination. Explore the glorious old town, the cultural monuments and possibly the most famous one here, the UNESCO listed Cathedral of St James. Wander and discover the historic core and waterfront. Some good boutique shopping too. Dinner on board.

Day 7 ŠIBENIK - SPLIT (B,L)

We continue south to Split, Croatia's second largest city where Roman Emperor Diocletian built himself a retirement palace now under UNESCO protection. Split waterfront is a happening place and there's a buzz along the beautiful wide promenade. A local guide meets us on arrival for a walk through the heart of the bustling old town and the market.

Day 8 SPLIT - METKOVIĆ (B, L, CD)

Today we cruise to Metković, on the banks of the river Neretva after which the delta is named. Here, mandarins arow by the water channels and we take a barge ride to explore the groves, the flora and fauna, wild birds and the traditional way of life of the Neretva people. There's a delightful, "time warp" feeling like nowhere else on the coast. Narona holds remains of a Roman temple – the Augusteum – and seventeen monumental marble sculptures of Roman emperors and their family members. This is where the ancient Illyrians, Greeks, Romans once sailed, and, according to legend, the pirates of Neretva planned their raids on enemy galleys. Captain's dinner with live entertainment on board scheduled for this

Day 9 METKOVIĆ - KORČULA (B. L)

Departure towards Korčula, an island best known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, the famous explorer with a swim stop and lunch on board. Korčula Town commonly referred to be a "miniature Dubrovnik", as it encased by medieval stone ramparts and towers. Sightseeing with a local guide through the old town and tiny streets, built in a fish bone pattern for a reason that you will hear about! Lots of simple konobas, restaurants and cool cocktail bars for chill out time. Overnight in Korčula.

Day 10 KORČULA - DUBROVNIK (B, L)

There is no better way to catch first sight of famous Dubrovnik than from the sea and this is our final destination - Dubrovnik. It is one of the few walled cities on the sea in the world. Writer George Bernard Shaw described it as "heaven on earth". We cruise alongside the old city walls for a true perspective of the majesty of this place. Lunch is served on deck as we head for Gruz harbour to dock. Once moored, we transfer to the old town for a guided walking tour of this unforgettable place. ITINERARY:

Day 1 TOWN OF KASTAV (D)

Situated on a hill, with panoramic view of the Kvarner Bay which is special in any season, but especially in the spring, the old town hides the secrets engraved in the cobbled streets and traditional houses.

Day 2 FORESTS OF THE OPATIJA RIVIERA (B, L)

Riding along the Opatija Riviera and Mošćenička Draga with a visit of a nearby forest for picking asparagus. Bring your good hiking shoes, long trousers, jacket and a cap. At the end of Opatija riviera situated above the sea, there is another hidden jewel of Liburnia coast - Brseč, we suggest a picnic break for trying all the varieties and combinations of the local wild asparagus.

Day 3 UČKA - PERMANI (B, L)

Bus ride to Poklon, and walking in the nature park or you can also take an educational path towards the highest peak at 1401 m. Učka covers the eponymous mountain and part of Ćićarija massif. On Poklon, in 1911, the tower was built with a view spreading all over Istria, the Alps, Italy and the bay of Kvarner. If you are lucky you will see the mountain salamanders, and more likely meet the salamander. Forwarding along with the bus, riding to the small town of Permani, Opatijas hinterland, visiting a family restaurant "Old Post" from the times of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, where you can taste local specialties, enjoy a fine glass of local wine and music.

Day 4 GORSKI KOTAR - VINODOLSKA DOLINA (VALLEY) (B, T, D)

Drive to Gorski Kotar highlands - Fužine, located by the lake Bajer and the famous cave spring "Vrelo". A short boat ride across the lake and lunch consisting of various forest goods such as eg. Nettle of the nearby forests. In this village Lič is the Sanctuary Majke Božje Snježne, which dates from 1733, when the villagers started to restore the church which was constantly crumbling, until August 5th when the snow fell. The snow chapel was build in which the holy Mary appeared. The journey continues to the fertile valley of Vinodol which apart from fine wine and beautiful views, hides a rich Frankopan heritage and world famous miniaturist museum - Julija Klovića. 6 viewpoints above 4 villages called "Eyes of Vinodol" will attract all the photography lovers. The ones more interested in history will be caught by the remains of the castles most famous feudal families in the Croatian Frankopan dukes. Gourmets will be delighted by tasting green-yellow specialty cheese, eggs and onions - Bribir prisnac with a nice glass of champagne from 1288 winemakers Palinkaš, named after the year of writing Vinodol Statute. Driving Crikvenica Riviera will round off the day.

Day 5 LOVRAN (B, L, D)

The bus ride to Lovran where we continue to walk on the coastal promenade known as the Promenade Franz Joseph, which is in its total length of 12 km long and extends from Volosko Opatija to Lovran. Along the way, discover the wonderful old oak trees, which are hovering over the sea and the most beautiful villas from the Austro-Hungarian Empire, hidden in the green laurel bushes. Lunch at a local restaurant based on specialties of asparagus and free time to participate in the festival of asparagus while a large frittata of 1000 eggs and asparagus is made. In the afternoon you can take a tour to Opatija park, treat yourselves to a cup of nettle tea or smoothie in one of the many cafes in Opatija or Volosko, the birthplace of the seismologist Mohorovičić accompanied with some of the top desserts in a small pastry shop. Dinner in the restaurant Zijavica in Mošćenička Draga with new friends, music and wine.

Day 6 DEPARTURE AND END OF THE PROGRAM (B)

After breakfast our tour ends with individual transfers to the airport, or a choice of optional excursions, cruises and hotel stays that can be arranged.



The bora is a dry, gusty northeasterly wind blowing from the mainland towards the sea.

There is a popular saying that claims that the bora is born in the town of Senj, gets married in the town of Bakar and dies in Rijeka - the biggest Croatian port.

A great idea would be to check this out, right?





ITINERARY:

Day 1 RIJEKA (L)

Bora brings out the crystal sea, sky and good visibility so we recommend a visit to Trsat castle, located high above Rijeka. From Trsat tower the view stretches across the magnificent Kvarner bay, the city of Rijeka and Opatija as well as the nature park Učka and the islands of Cres and Krk. After a must-have cappuccino, out recommendation would be to try the Kvarner bay prawns which are meant to the best in the world. Their natural habitat is low-sea terrain with lots of fresh water springs making them soft and sweet in taste.

Day 2 BAKAR – SENJ - ISLAND PAG (B, D)

The path of bora continues towards the town of Bakar. Enjoy the panoramic view of the bay and taste the delicacy "baškoti". In Bakarac you can see the old "tuneras" wooden ladders on which fishermen waited for hours until the fish especially tuna came and they finally could catch them in their nets. This small town is also known for its strong bora since it lies in a ravine. A special sight are the stone terraces of former vineyards, which are slowly being renovated and where the grapes for the famous sparkling wine ripen - Bakarska vodica. The trip along the Croatian coast continues with panoramic views of the 1430m long Krk bridge. A short stop is planned in the town of Senj, also known for strong bora, and the fortress of the Uskok "Nehaj" - today a museum and a landmark. Built in 1558 it is square shaped and oriented to the sky. The route takes us to the ferry port Prizna for the island of Pag.

Day 3 ISLAND PAG (B, T)

Pag is famous for its award-winning local products - the sheep cheese, the Pag lamb, the salt production as well as for the production of Pag lace. The entirely bare landscape partly resembles the lunar landscape due to the bora impact. The bora, on the other hand, brings salt to the stonewall guarded pastures. In 2010, Pag lace was included on the list of the intangible cultural heritage of UNESCO. Credit for maintaining the mentioned tradition goes to the Benedictine monastery of St. Margaret and lately the lace association of the city of Pag. You will not only remember your stay on the island for the hospitality of the local people, but also for the delicious specialties: we recommend a good glass of wine in the well known konobas, paired with salt coated fish or lamb baked under the iron bell (peka) or on a spit.

Day 4 NIN (F

Finally a visit to the town of the Croatian kings - Nin. There is much that will inspire you here, especially the old city bridge and an ancient Croatian ship from the 11th century - the Condura Croatica. The Church of the Holy Cross called "the smallest cathedral in the world" is the most valuable preserved monument of early Croatian religious architecture and one of Nins symbols. Nin is known for its sandy beaches as well as the salt factory. Built more than 1500 years ago it offers now a museum and a salt house to stroll through. Even today the salt is traditionally handmade here with the help of the sun, the Adriatic Sea and the bora from Velebit.
