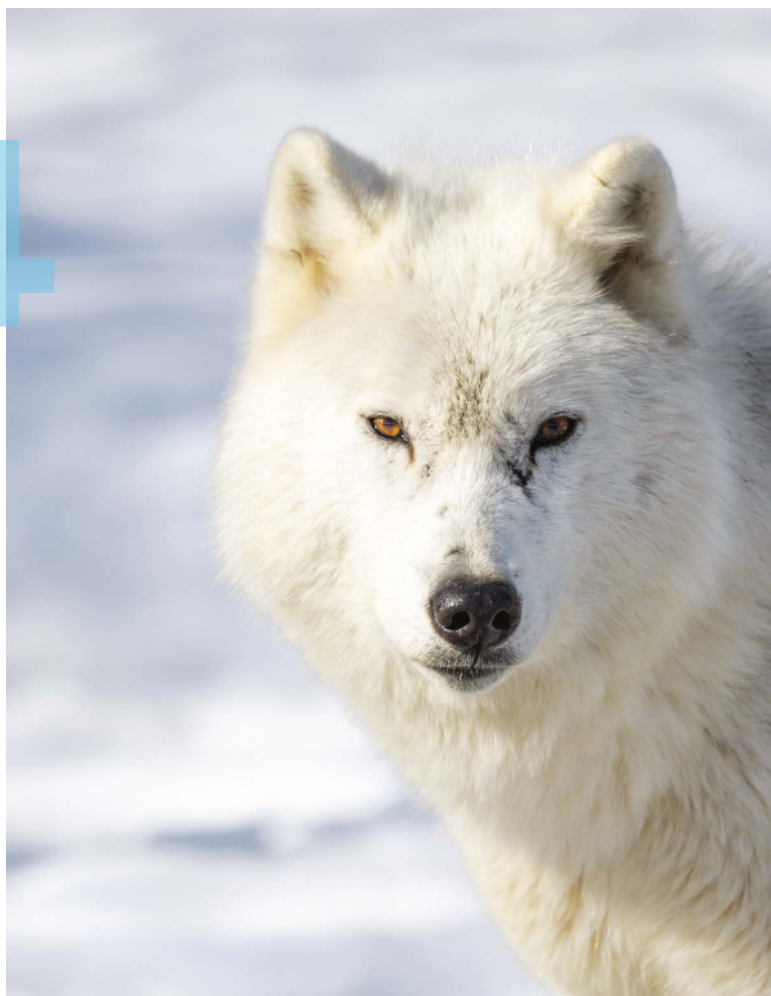
THE BEST EXPERTS

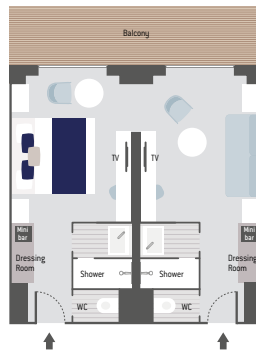
